



Privacy Policy

This document outlines our privacy policy for British Laureate School. Your privacy is important to us. It is our policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect from you across our website, www.blsmohali.com, and other sites we own and operate.

Information We Collect

Log Data When you visit our websites, our servers may automatically log the standard data provided by your web browser. It may include your computer's Internet Protocol (IP) address, your browser type and version, the pages you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on each page, and other details.

Device Data We may also collect data about the device you're using to access our website. This data may include the device type, operating system, unique device identifiers, device settings, and geolocation data. What we collect can depend on the individual settings of your device and software. We recommend checking the policies of your device manufacturer or software provider to learn what information they make available to us.

Personal Information We may ask for personal information, such as your:

- Work address
- Payment information

Legal Bases for Processing We will process your personal information lawfully, fairly, and in a transparent manner. We collect and process information about you only where we have legal bases for doing so. By using any of the websites we own and operate, you consent to providing us with personal data for the purposes set out in this privacy policy.

These legal bases depend on the services you use and how you use them, meaning we collect and use your information only where:

It's necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are a party or to take steps at your
request before entering into such a contract (e.g., when we provide a service you request from
us);





- It satisfies a legitimate interest (which is not overridden by your data protection interests), such as for research and development, to market and promote our services, and to protect our legal rights and interests;
- You give us consent to do so for a specific purpose (e.g., you might consent to us sending you our newsletter); or
- We need to process your data to comply with a legal obligation.
