Preparing Children for a New School Experience

Starting at a new school can be both exciting and challenging, especially for our youngest learners in Early Years and those transitioning to a new school in Primary wing. We understand that change can be overwhelming, and we are here to make this transition as smooth and joyful as possible.





For Early Years – Laying the Foundation with Joy and Comfort:

- Familiarization is Key: Talk to your child about the new school environment in a positive light. Share stories about making new friends, playing games, and discovering new toys and learning tools. You can also show them pictures or take a drive by the school building to create a sense of familiarity.

- Practice Makes Perfect: Establish a consistent morning and bedtime routine to help them adjust to the new schedule. You can practice the school routine by role-playing a "school day" at home, including activities like packing their bag, saying goodbye, and returning home.







- Building Independence: Encourage self-help skills like using the washroom independently, washing hands, opening lunch boxes, and putting on shoes. These small achievements build confidence and reduce anxiety.
- **Emotional Readiness:** Read storybooks about starting school and encourage them to express their feelings. Reassure them that it's okay to feel a mix of excitement and nervousness. Positive affirmations like "You are brave and smart!" can work wonders.

For Primary Years – Easing the Transition with Confidence:

- **Positive Conversations:** Discuss the new opportunities and experiences they will have, such as making new friends, exploring different subjects, and participating in extracurricular activities. Encourage a growth mindset by emphasizing that change is an adventure filled with learning.
- Virtual or Physical School Visits: If feasible, visit the school building or explore its online presence to build familiarity. Knowing where the classrooms, playgrounds, and other facilities are can make them feel more secure.





- Connecting with Peers: If possible, arrange meetings with other children who will be joining the same school. Building connections before the first day can greatly reduce the feeling of unfamiliarity.
- Encourage Open Dialogue: Allow your child to share their worries and address them with empathy and positivity. Practice positive self-talk with statements like "I can make new friends" or "I am ready for new adventures."
- Organizational Skills: Reinforce organizational skills like packing their backpack, labelling their belongings, and maintaining a planner. Encourage them to take responsibility for their school supplies, which fosters independence and confidence.
- Involvement in Preparation: Involve them in the process of buying school supplies, choosing their school bag, and organizing their study space at home. This gives them a sense of ownership and excitement about the new beginning.
